

School Options for Moss Students 2020-2021

Please read through each of these carefully before selecting the best option for your student(s).

Regular Schedule

- Parents are strongly encouraged to transport students to school.
- Masks are mandatory on all school transportation.
- Students will attend full-day classes on campus.
- Social distancing measures will be implemented.
- Students can transition to the Blended or Virtual option from the Regular Schedule at any time during a semester but must finish the semester in the option they select.
- If our school is forced into a COVID related shut-down, we will continue instruction online via Google or ZOOM.
- The State Department of Education may mandate masks in the classroom.

Blended Schedule (Online and Regular combined)

- **Students that choose the Blended Option must remain on a Blended schedule the remainder of the semester.**
- Students will have a morning or afternoon schedule on campus based on the courses they are enrolled in. They are not to be on campus during their Virtual scheduled time.
- Parents will be responsible for transporting their child or children from school for morning sessions and to school for afternoon sessions.
- Sessions will start or end at lunch to facilitate access to meals.
(PK-2 11:00-11:25) (3-6 12:25-12:50) (HS 11:40-12:05).
- Learning occurring outside of the on-site schedule will be determined by the administration on a case by case basis. It may include virtual or homebound options.
- Attendance will be recorded by teachers for time spent on-site.
- Students will be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities and may return at designated sites/times for practice or transport to games or scrimmages.

Virtual Schedule (online)

- **Students that choose Virtual must remain on that schedule for the remainder of the semester.**
- Students will receive all instruction through the district's Virtual Learning Software.
- Parents will be responsible for ensuring the completion of coursework.
- Progress will be monitored by the Moss School Administration with individualized weekly progress goals established for the purpose of attendance and eligibility.
- Internet access is the responsibility of families; hotspot and device access will be provided as available and determined by need.
- Students will be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities.
- Students will only be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities and may be on campus for designated practices or transport to school activities.
- Students may also be on campus for tutoring at times specified by the principal.

Policies will be updated as needed to meet all State Department of Education mandates.
