Moss Safe Return Plan

1. Moss Schools will post mask recommendation and mask etiquette posters and CDC guidelines in common areas for students as reference.
2. Moss Schools has modified facilities and schedules to help limit large gatherings and more entries and exits to improve social distancing. Changes have been made to the morning routine and cafeteria to also allow social distancing and separation of students from the elementary and secondary level.
3. Moss will teach the importance of hand washing and proper sanitation practices
4. Moss has purchased additional sanitation equipment for air quality, sprayers, sanitation wipes, additional cleaning materials, and staff to help with the cleaning of the classroom and facilities.
5. Moss will continue to make facility upgrades that will give students isolation areas if the student becomes symptomatic.
6. Students that become symptomatic will be screened for temperature and parents/guardians notified to pick their student up from school. Students will not be allowed to be at school or ride a bus if temperature exceeds 100 degrees Fahrenheit.
7. Moss Schools will have technology available for students for virtual learning.
8. Classrooms will be cleaned daily and teachers and other faculty will be able to clean facilities as needed
9. Hughes County Health Department will be in communication with the school district in regards to positive cases.
10. Staff and Students will be notified of vaccination sites and dates.
11. Moss I.S.D. will offer services, including but not limited to services to address students' academic needs and students **as well as** staff members' social, emotional, mental health and other needs, which may include student health and food services.
